Follow Christ's Steps Closely

Jesus set an example for us to imitate, especially when we face trials or persecution. (1Pe 2:21-23) Although Jesus was insulted, he never retaliated, even when undergoing suffering. (Mr 15:29-32) What helped him to endure? He resolved to do Jehovah's will. (Joh 6:38) He also focused on "the joy that was set before him."—Heb 12:2.

How do we react when we are mistreated because of our faith? True Christians do not "return evil for evil." (Ro 12:14, 17) When we imitate the way Christ endured suffering, we can rejoice because we have God's approval. —Mt 5:10-12; 1Pe 4:12-14.



Social Networking—Avoid the Pitfalls

WHY IMPORTANT: Like most tools, social networks can be helpful or harmful. Some Christians choose not to use social networks. Other Christians use social networks to keep in touch with family and friends. However, the Devil wants us to use social networks unwisely, which could damage our reputation and our spirituality. Like Jesus, we can use principles from God's Word to identify dangers and avoid them. —Lu 4:4. 8, 12.



PITFALLS TO AVOID:

- Using social media excessively. Spending countless hours using social networks or social media can deprive us of precious time needed for spiritual pursuits
- Viewing questionable material. Looking at provocative images can lead to pornography addiction or immorality. Reading apostate material or blogs can damage one's faith
- Posting improper comments or photos. Because the heart is treacherous, a person may
 be inclined to post improper comments or photos on a social network. However, this could
 damage someone's reputation or cause him to stumble spiritually

Parents, Give Your Children the Best Chance to Succeed



God-fearing parents long to see their children become faithful servants of Jehovah. Parents can help them to do so by impressing Bible teachings on the hearts of their children from infancy. (De 6:7; Pr 22:6) Does this require self-sacrifice? Most certainly! But the rewards are worth the effort.—3Jo 4.

Parents can learn much from Joseph and Mary. They "were accustomed to go from year to year to Jerusalem for the festival of the Passover," even though this required effort and expense. (Lu 2:41) Apparently, they gave priority to their family's spiritual needs. Similarly, parents today can point their children in the right direction by taking every opportunity to teach them by word and example.—Ps 127:3-5.

DID YOU KNOW?

Although raised in a spiritual household, Jesus' half brothers did not put faith in him until after his death. (Joh 7:5; Ac 1:14) Later, two of them, James and Jude, wrote the Bible books bearing their names.
