## ISAIAH 52-57 | Christ Suffered for Us



### 53:3-5

- "He was despised and was avoided by men . . . We considered him as plagued, stricken by God and afflicted"
- Jesus was despised and charged with blasphemy.
   Some believed that God was punishing him, as if plaguing him with a loathsome disease

### 53:10

- "It was Jehovah's will to crush him, ... and through him the delight of Jehovah will have success"
- Jehovah no doubt suffered when he saw his Son put to death. But he delighted to see Jesus' absolute faithfulness. Jesus' death provided an answer to Satan's challenge regarding the loyalty of God's servants and brought benefits to repentant humans. It thus helped to accomplish "Jehovah's will"

# Make Wise Use of Bible Literature

Jesus taught: "You received free, give free." (Mt 10:8) We adhere to that clear direction by not charging people for a copy of the Bible or our Bible-based literature. (2Co 2:17) Nevertheless, these publications contain precious truths from God's Word. Great effort and expense are involved in printing literature and shipping it to congregations around the world. Therefore, we should take only what we need.

Use discernment when giving literature to others, even at public witnessing locations. (Mt 7:6) Instead of simply handing out literature to passersby, make an effort to converse with them to determine their interest. Can you answer yes to at least one of the questions in the accompanying box? If you are unable to determine someone's interest, it is best to give him a tract. Of course, if he asks for a magazine or another publication, we will gladly give him a copy.—Pr 3:27, 28.

# "The year of Jehovah's goodwill" is not a literal year

- It is a time period during which Jehovah gives meek ones the opportunity to respond to his proclamation of freedom
- In the first century, the year
  of goodwill started when Jesus
  began his ministry in 29 C.E.
  and lasted until "the day of
  vengeance" of Jehovah when
  Jerusalem was destroyed in
  70 C.E.
- In our day, the year of goodwill began with Jesus' enthronement in heaven in 1914 and will conclude with the great tribulation

# Jehovah blesses his people with "big trees of righteousness"

- The tallest trees in the world usually grow together in forests, where individual trees support one another
- Large root systems may be intertwined, anchoring the trees and providing resistance to storms
- Tall trees provide protective shade for saplings, and leaves that fall from the trees enrich the soil beneath

All members of the worldwide Christian congregation benefit from the support and protection of the "big trees of righteousness," the anointed remnant

### Rejoice in Your Hope



Hope is like an anchor. (Heb 6:19) It helps us to avoid spiritual shipwreck when we face stormy seas. (1Ti 1:18, 19) Stormy seas may include personal disappointments, material loss, prolonged illness, the death of a loved one, or any other threat to our integrity.

Faith and hope enable us to see clearly the promised reward. (2Co 4:16-18; Heb 11:13, 26, 27) So whether our hope is heavenly or earthly, we must regularly nourish it by meditating on the promises recorded in God's Word. Then, when we are distressed by trials, it will be easier to maintain our joy. -1Pe 1:6, 7.

# ISAIAH 63-66 | New Heavens and a New Earth Will Cause Great Rejoicing

God's promise of restoration recorded in Isaiah chapter 65 is so certain that Jehovah speaks of it as if it were already being fulfilled.

### 65:17

Jehovah creates new heavens and a new earth, where the former things are not called to mind

### What are the new heavens?

- A new government that will bring about righteous conditions on earth
- It was established in 1914 when Christ was enthroned as King of God's Kingdom

### What is the new earth?

 A society of people from all nationalities, languages, and races who gladly submit to the rulership of the new heavenly government

### How will the former things not be called to mind?

- The causes of hurtful memories—physical, mental, and emotional suffering—will no longer exist
- Faithful humans will enjoy life to the full and will treasure the pleasant memories of each passing day





## Help Your Children to Develop Unshakable Faith in the Creator







Creation declares Jehovah's glory. (Ps 19:1-4; 139:14) However, the Devil's world promotes God-dishonoring theories about the origin of life. (Ro 1:18-25) How can you prevent such ideas from taking root in the mind and heart of your children? Help them from an early age to develop faith that Jehovah exists and cares about them personally. (2Co 10:4, 5; Eph 6:16) Draw out their deepest thoughts about what they are taught at school, and use the many tools available to reach their heart.—Pr 20:5; Jas 1:19.
