A CENTER FOR DIVINE EDUCATION

All those serving at the Watchtower Educational Center have dedicated their lives to Jehovah God and have offered their services to support the Bible educational work of Jehovah’s Witnesses.

Jehovah finds great delight in sharing knowledge with others. He says: “I, Jehovah, am your God, the One teaching you to benefit yourself.” (Isaiah 48:17) How thankful we are to have such a loving Grand Instructor! Jehovah has always provided us with an abundance of divine wisdom and knowledge. By taking in knowledge of God, we have the hope of everlasting life.—Isaiah 30:20; John 17:3, footnote.

In some 240 lands, more than eight million Witnesses of Jehovah are striving to help others gain an accurate knowledge of the only true God, Jehovah. To help equip those sharing in the preaching and disciple-making work, a number of theocratic schools have been established.

Gilead School

The Watchtower Bible School of Gilead provides intensive training to experienced and well-qualified brothers and sisters who are already in some form of special full-time service. This training helps them to cultivate spiritual qualities that will be needed in their assignment and skills that will enable them to be better Bible teachers.

Some graduates of Gilead receive assignments as (1) Bethelites in key positions of oversight, (2) circuit overseers, or (3) missionaries in densely populated areas. Thus, they will be better able to strengthen and stabilize congregations and the preaching work.


Branch Committee School

The unity among Jehovah's people is a hallmark of pure worship. (1 Corinthians 1:10) Branches play a vital role in promoting this unity.

The School for Branch Committee Members began in 1995. (The wives of Branch Committee members began to be included in 2011.) This eight-week course is designed to provide training and direction to Branch Committee members who serve in some 90 branch offices around the world. As a result, all are able to work together in unity.

Illustrations have always been a part of true worship. Prominent features of Solomon’s temple, for instance, were carvings of cherubs, palm trees, and blossoms.—1 Kings 5:18; 6:29.

We use art and video to follow this Biblical pattern by providing visual aids for Watch Tower publications, the jw.org website, and videos. Some of the principal steps in producing these visuals are listed below.

Concept Meeting

After receiving text or an outline, a story or design team suggests how best to illustrate the subject

Storyboards/Sketches

Artists depict concepts with rough sketches

3-D Design

Computer software is used to create backgrounds, special effects, and animations





Shooting Pictures and Videos

A production crew, along with models and actors, uses one of our studios or a location outside Bethel to shoot photos and/or videos



Digital Illustration

Instead of using pencils, oils, and watercolors, our artists now “paint” directly on a digital canvas



Page Layouts

Once the imagery and text are complete, a designer puts it together in a pleasing layout



Video Editing

Video segments are trimmed and reassembled in a way that best presents the story
