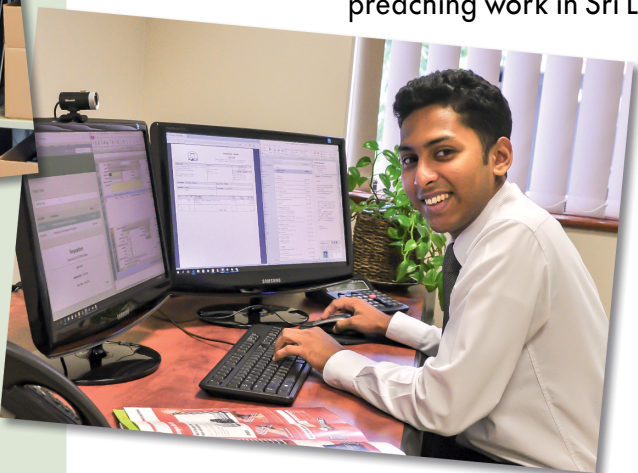
# SERVICE
