## What Work Is Done at a Branch Office?

In some 240 lands, more than eight million Witnesses of Jehovah are preaching the good news of God’s Kingdom in response to the commission that Jesus gave his followers. (Matthew 24:14; 28:19, 20) To organize this work, there are more than 85 branch offices worldwide, all serving under the direction of the Governing Body of Jehovah’s Witnesses, located in Warwick, New York, U.S.A.

Branch offices coordinate the Kingdom-preaching work and care for the needs of Jehovah’s Witnesses within a specific geographic area. The Governing Body appoints experienced elders to serve as members of a Branch Committee. As representatives of the Governing Body in their assigned territory, Branch Committee members faithfully carry out the direction coming from God’s Word and “the faithful and discreet slave.”

## DIRECTING THE WORK

The branch office supervises the activities of Jehovah's Witnesses in one or more countries in various ways.

The Service Department cares for matters related to the preaching work and provides Scriptural guidance regarding congregation activities. It also arranges conventions, assemblies, and theocratic schools. In addition, the Service Department looks after congregation territory boundaries and determines where Kingdom Halls and Assembly Halls are needed.

When medical emergencies arise, the branch office provides loving support and direction through the Hospital Information Department. This department helps Jehovah's Witnesses to obtain competent medical treatment without blood and strives to promote a spirit of cooperation between doctors and their Witness patients.

Another area in which the branch provides direction and assistance is disaster relief. The local branch office is quick to respond, supplying provisions and funds to those in need.

# CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE

## Building Houses of Worship

The branch office is responsible for approving and overseeing the construction of Kingdom Halls and Assembly Halls and for ensuring that existing halls are being maintained properly. Construction is coordinated through the Local Design/Construction Department. This department uses volunteers to develop architectural plans and works with field representatives to schedule projects. Volunteers are used to build and maintain facilities, which results in buildings that are economical, practical, and comfortable.

## Using Donated Funds Wisely

In order to get the most value from existing facilities, the Local Design/Construction Department arranges for Kingdom Halls to be inspected regularly. This helps to ensure that any safety or maintenance issues are handled promptly. The department also provides maintenance training for local congregation members.





# TRANSLATION

## Words That Touch the Heart

Bible truths often reach the heart more quickly when people read, hear, or see Bible-based publications presented in their mother tongue. Thus, we translate publications for written languages and sign language. We also prepare audio and video recordings. When the need arises for publications in additional languages or formats, the branch office makes recommendations to the Governing Body.

## Remote Translation Offices

The Brazil branch translates material into 12 languages and has 10 remote translation offices. These offices are usually located near communities where the language being translated is spoken. This helps the translators to be immersed in their target language while they share in the preaching work, attend Christian meetings, and engage in daily activities. The Translation Department also prepares material for meetings, convention programs, our [jw.org](http://jw.org) website, and various theocratic schools.

## PRINTING

The Brazil branch has been printing Bible-based literature since 1926. As a result, millions of people have responded to the good news found in God's Word. The Kingdom message is now available online in hundreds of languages on [jw.org](http://jw.org), but the printed page remains a powerful tool for reaching hearts worldwide.

The Brazil branch office produces books, Bibles, magazines, and brochures in 70 languages.

### STATISTICS

- The two high-speed printing presses together can print about 390,000 sixteen-page magazines per hour
- A single press can print 55 magazines per second
- A paper roll weighs 1,750 kilograms, has about 22 kilometers of paper, and is used up in 25 minutes
- The binder can produce up to 110,000 books per day

# BINDERY AND SHIPPING

In the Bindery, book pages are gathered and a special glue is applied to attach the cover. Next, the books are cut to their final size and, after being packaged in plastic, are taken by lift trucks to the Shipping Department. Much research and many tests are done to ensure that the materials and methods used produce strong, durable books.

Every month the Shipping Department processes literature requests from the more than 12,000 congregations in Brazil. The department prepares all the documentation needed to ship Bible literature to other countries and to import Bible literature produced at other branches.

This department also arranges for the delivery of literature to congregations throughout Brazil and some neighboring countries.

The literature warehouse stocks publications in more than 137 languages.





# SUPPORT SERVICES
